# DON'T "RAG" ALSO DON'T BE MUTE WITNESS TO RAGGING

### **RAGGING:**

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of harassing, teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

The conduct includes but is not restricted to any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher; tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students; any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other students; any act of physical abuse including all variant sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, health or person; any act or abuse by sp vords. emails, post, public insults which or passively participating in the discomfiture to the or or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing on power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

### **PUNISHMENT:**

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty or ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process.
- With holding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semester.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
- Fine of Rs. 25,000/- and Rs. 1 Lakh.
- Collective punishment : When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

## PHASE WISE TRAINING AND TIME DISTRIBUTION FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

#### Phase I -Total 12 months

First Professional phase is of 12 months including Foundation Course of one week and university exams.

It shall consist of -

Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Introduction to Community Medicine, Humanities, Professional development including Attitude, Ethics & Communication (AETCOM) module, family adoption program through village outreach where-in each student shall adopt minimum of three (03) families and preferably at least five (05) families, Pandemic module and early clinical exposure, ensuring alignment & all types of integration and simulation- based learning.

#### Phase II- Total 12 months

Second professional phase is of 12 months (including university exams)

It shall consist of-

- \* Pathology, Pharmacology, Microbiology, family visit under Community Medicine, General Surgery, General Medicine & Obstetrics & Gynecology, Professional development including AETCOM module, simulation-based learning and introduction to clinical subjects ensuring both alignment & all types of integration.
- \* The clinical exposure to learners will be in the form of learner-doctor method of clinical training in all phases. The emphasis will be on primary, preventive and comprehensive health care. A part of training during clinical postings will take place at the primary level of health care. Learning experiences shall involve:
- Experience in recognizing and managing common problems seen in outpatient, inpatient and emergency settings
- Involvement in patient care as a team member
- Involvement in patient management and performance of basic procedures.

#### Phase III - Total 30 months (12+18)

A) Third Professional Part I (12 months, including University exams)

It shall consist of-

\* Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Community Medicine, Medicine & allied, Surgery & allied, Pediatrics and Obstetric & Gynecology including AETCOM, Pandemic module, Clinical teaching in General Medicine, General Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pediatrics, Orthopedics, Dermatology, Community Medicine, Psychiatry, Respiratory Medicine, Radio-diagnosis (& Radiotherapy) and Anesthesiology & Professional development.

Electives (1 month) shall be included here. These will be in 2 blocks of 15 days each in Final first; 1<sup>st</sup> block after annual exam of III MBBS part I and 2<sup>nd</sup> block after the end of 1st elective.

### B) Third Professional Part II (18 months, including University exam)

It shall consist of-

Medicine and allied specialties (General Medicine, Psychiatry, Dermatology, Venereology and Leprosy, Respiratory Medicine including Tuberculosis), Surgery and allied specialties (General Surgery, Otorhinolaryngology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Dentistry, Physical Medicine and rehabilitation, Anesthesiology and Radiodiagnosis), Obstetrics and Gynecology (including Farnily Welfare), Pediatrics, AETCOM module

#### Criteria for passing in a subject:

- A candidate shall obtain 50% marks in University conducted examination separately in Theory and Practical. (Practical includes: practical/ clinical and viva voce) in order to be declared as passed in that subject.
- In subjects that have two papers, the learner must secure minimum 50% of marks in aggregate (both papers together) to pass in the said subject.
- There shall be no grace marks to be considered for passing in an examination.
- Students not satisfying above passing criteria will be marked as 'FAILED' in university exam
- Students will not be allowed more than four (04) attempts for first year (First professional MBBS) and no students will be allowed to continue undergraduate medical course after nine (09) years from the date of admission into the course.

# Criteria for being eligible in university examination of a subject:

### 1. ATTENDANCE:

- Attendance requirements are 75% in theory and 80% in practical /clinical for eligibility to appear for the examinations in that subject. In subjects that are taught in more than one phase the learner must have 75% attendance in theory and 80% in practical in each phase of instruction in that subject. There shall be minimum of 80% attendance in family visits under Family adoption programme. Each student shall adopt minimum 3 families and preferably five families.
- If an examination comprises more than one subject (for e.g., General Surgery and allied branches), the candidate must have a minimum of 75% attendance in each subject including its allied branches, and 80% attendance in each clinical posting.
- Learners who do not have at least 75% attendance in the electives will not be eligible for the Third Professional - Part II examination/NExT.
- 75% attendance in Professional Development Programme (AETCOM Module) shall be mandatory for eligibility to appear for final examination in each professional year
- 2. INTERNAL ASSESSMENT:
- Internal assessment shall be based on day-to-day assessment. It shall relate to different ways in which learners participate in learning process including assignments, preparation for seminar, clinical case presentation, preparation of clinical case for discussion, clinical case study/ problem solving exercise, participation in project for health care in the community.
- Internal assessment shall not be added to summative assessment. However, internal assessment will be displayed under a separate column in detailed marks card.
- Learners must have completed the required certifiable competencies for that phase of training and completed the log book appropriate for that phase of training to be eligible for appearing at the final university examination of that subject.
- Regular periodic examinations shall be conducted throughout the course.
- An end of posting clinical assessment shall be conducted for each clinical posting in each professional year.
- When subjects are taught in more than one phase, the internal assessment will be done in each phase and will contribute proportionately to final assessment.
  For example, General Medicine will be assessed in second Professional, Professional Part I and third Professional Part II, independently.
- Day to day records and log book (including required skill certifications) will be given importance in internal assessment. Internal assessment will be based on competencies and skills.
- Submission of the log book/ case record to the department is required for eligibility to appear for the final examination of the subject.
- The final internal assessment in a broad clinical specialty (e.g., Surgery and allied specialties etc.) shall comprise of marks from all the constituent specialties. The proportion of the marks for each constituent specialty will be determined by the time of instruction allotted to each.

Learners must secure at least 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and practical /clinical; not less than 40% marks in theory and practical separately) for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing at the final University examination of that subject. Internal assessment marks will reflect as separate head of passing at the summative examination.

Students not satisfying above criteria will not be allowed in university exam of that year (detained students)

- Detained students will have to satisfy the criteria related to ATTENDANCE and INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (as mentioned above) before being eligible in 'supplementary university exam.'
- Supplementary examinations and declaration of results will be processed within 3-6 weeks from the date of declaration of the results of the main examination for every professional year, so that the candidates, who pass, can join the main batch for progression.

- If the candidate fails in the supplementary examination of first MBBS, he shall join the batch of next academic /subsequent year. There shall be no supplementary batches. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt.
- A candidate, who fails in the First Professional examination, shall not be allowed to join the Second Professional.
- A candidate, who fails in the second Professional examination, shall be allowed to join the third Professional Part I training, however he shall not be allowed to appear for the examination unless he has passed second professional examination.
- A candidate who fails in the third Professional (Part I) examination shall be allowed to join third Professional part II training; however he shall not be allowed to appear for the examination unless he has passed second professional examination.


